

# Website cookie policy

## 1) Cookies and similar technology

A cookie is a small text file which is placed onto your computer or electronic device when you access our website. Similar technologies include web beacons, action tags, local shared objects ('flash cookies') and single-pixel gifs. Such technologies can be used to track users' actions and activities, and to store information about them. We use these cookies and/or similar technologies on this website for the following purposes:

- To identify trusted web traffic.
- To store the user's cookie consent state.
- To preserve user session state across page requests.
- To register a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.
- Used by Google Analytics to throttle request rate.
- To collect statistics on the user's visits to the website, such as the number of visits, average time spent on the website and what pages have been read.
- Used by Piwik Analytics Platform to track page requests from the visitor during the session.
- Used to send data to Google Analytics about the visitor's device and behaviour. Tracks the visitor across devices and marketing channels.
- To register a unique ID on mobile devices to enable tracking based on geographical GPS location.
- Used by Google DoubleClick to register and report the website user's actions after viewing or clicking one of the advertiser's ads with the purpose of measuring the efficacy of an ad and to present targeted ads to the user.
- To register a unique ID that is used by Google to keep statistics of how the visitor uses YouTube videos across different websites.
- To check if the user's browser supports cookies.
- To estimate the users' bandwidth on pages with integrated YouTube videos.
- To collect data on the user's visits to the website, such as which pages have been read.
- To register a unique ID to keep statistics of what videos from YouTube the user has seen.
- To determine the optimal video quality based on the visitor's device and network settings.
- To store the user's video player preferences using embedded YouTube video.

## 2) Information Collected

We may obtain information about your computer or any other electronic device which you use to access our website, such as your IP address, your browser and/or other internet log information. We will treat this information as your personal information.

## 3) Consent for Cookies

In most cases we will need your consent to use cookies on this website. The exception is where the cookie is essential for us to provide you with a service you have requested, or essential to the inherent functionality of the website (e.g., to enable you to store items in a shopping basket and/or to use our check-out process).

Where we wish to use cookies that require your consent you will be asked whether you consent to the use of cookies in the following manner:

A pop-up will ask the user to consent by clicking one of 3 options:

- Reject (Decline all non-essential cookies)
- Accept (Accept all cookies used on the website)
- Settings (Allows detailed access to blocking particular cookies)

Cookies need to be actively declined to be removed from your browsing experience.

#### 4) Third-Party Cookies

We work with third party suppliers who may also set cookies on our website. These cookies and their third-party owners are included in the table below. By consenting to the use of cookies on our site you will be consenting to the use of these cookies. These cookies may be used to collect the following information:

- Tracking based on GPS location.
- The user's actions after viewing or clicking one of the advertiser's ads with the purpose of measuring the efficacy of an ad and to present targeted ads to the user.
- Statistics of how the visitor uses YouTube videos across different websites.
- If the user's browser supports cookies.
- To estimate the users' bandwidth on pages with integrated YouTube videos.
- Data on the user's visits to the website, such as which pages have been read.
- Statistics of what videos from YouTube the user has seen.
- Optimal video quality based on the visitor's device and network settings.
- The user's video player preferences using embedded YouTube video.
